Parent/Player Contract

Mission:

Insanity Volleyball Club is a competitive club in the North Texas Region of USA volleyball. Our philosophy is rooted in teaching strong fundamentals while combining positive encouragement, competitive growth, and strength training to develop well-rounded athletes and leaders.

Team Practices:

Players **MUST** be on time for practice. "On time" means on the court with shoes on. Practice T-shirt must be worn for ALL practices.

Any player with 3 unexcused practices will be called before the club director.

Excused practices:

- Illness
- Family Emergency
- Any school sanctioned sport or activity scheduled at the same time as Insanity Volleyball Club practice.

Our goal is to ensure players have the opportunity to make up practices if time allows it. Please let your coach know as soon as you know you are unable to be at practice.

Team Tournaments:

Players must attend all scheduled tournaments; we will release the tournament schedule to parents, as soon as it is finalized. We ask that parents look this over at the beginning of the season to ensure we have no conflicts ahead of tournament season.

Coaches will send out an itinerary via email 48 hours prior to the schedule to ensure parents and players have a clear expectations of what is asked of them at the tournament. Players are to be their ready for warm ups at that time stated by coach.

Insanity Volleyball Club has a duty to officiate during all tournaments. Officiating is a shared responsibility- all club players must fulfill their responsibilities to officiate. All players **MUST** stay at court until team is done with officiating. Leaving prior to

officiating results the team to receive a consequence at next practice as well as loss of playing time in next tournament.

All team members must be scorekeeping certified. Failure to certify is not an option. Scorekeeping Clinics are found through your USA Volleyball account. The cost is \$10 and each player is responsible for the cost. This must be completed by December 1.

Overnight Travel:

During overnight travel curfew is decided by head coach. We encourage all athletes to stay with parents or another team parent. It is the parents responsibility to arrange travel/housing for their daughter, if they cannot attend. Coaches are not permitted to arrange rides or hotel accommodations for athletes.

Player Club Insurance:

Insanity Volleyball Club offers club insurance with your paid in FULL club fees. Should a player suffer a complete season ending injury, then Insanity Volleyball Club will prorate the remaining number of days left in the season and refund players club fees minus uniform costs fee, and any fees already submitted for qualifiers.

Media:

I authorize Insanity Volleyball Club permission to print, publish my child's photo and name to media such as Facebook, Instagram, our website... ect. in addition to teams finishes and achievements.

Payments:

Payment is due at signing day of player. See Financial Agreement for payment options. Payment is CASH, CHECK, CREDIT CARD (*credit card fee applies*). THERE WILL BE NO REFUNDS. If a player chooses to quit or is dismissed due to inappropriate behavior NO Refund will be given.

Parent/Player Expectations:

All players and parents are expected to positively represent Insanity Volleyball Club by conducting themselves in a respectful manner to all Insanity Volleyball Club coaches, players parents, opposing teams, opposing coaches, and USAV volleyball directors and coaches.

Insanity Volleyball Club practices and tournaments are "open" for parents, friends, and families to watch seating permitting. During these events players are expected to be focused on practices or tournament play. Parents are not permitted to sideline

coach from the stands. Insanity Volleyball Club reserves the right to close practices at the club director's discretion.

Dispute Policy:

If a parents has a dispute over a coaching decision, they must wait 24 hours before speaking to the coach, if a parent approaches a coach about playtime decisions during the tournament, then that player can be benched immediately. Please ensure you follow proper procedures; so the team does not suffer from your decision. If the problem concerns playtime or player discipline, the PLAYER must approach the coach first. Other players will never be discussed. If the parent is still showing concern or has a problem, they can ask for a meeting with the club director that will include the coach, player, and parent.

Even though the club director has a final say on a all disputes, the team coach will be supported with all playtime decisions. We at Insanity Volleyball Club will help make sure that the player understands the coach's thinking and communicates ways for them to improve and earn more playtime. Please email the coach and club director that you would like to meet briefly list your concerns ahead of time so that our meeting can be productive.

Playing Time:

It is nearly impossible to calculate "equal playing" time for the sport of volleyball due to its complex nature. What coaches do try to provide is fair time based on performance at the time of practice, attendance, and game situation, ect. The positional nature of volleyball combined with the complexity posed by attempting to balance the dual interests of distributing playing time fairly on individual level and achieving the goals and objective of the team as a whole requires understanding, that "fair" playing time does not necessarily mean "equal" playing time. If a player has a concern about playing time they must voice this to coach first, prior to a parent reaching out by email.

Waiver/Liability Release:

The undersigned ("Player") wishes to participate in volleyball practice and tournaments at locations leased or owned by or at other locations coordinated Insanity Volleyball Club, LLC, ("___Insanity Volleyball Club___"). The player hereby acknowledges that volleyball or any sporting event is an extreme test of a person's physical and mental limits and that Player's participation in or travel to a volleyball event may result in death, serious injury, or property damage. With a full understanding of the potential risks, the Player hereby KNOWING AND FREELY ASSUMES ALL SUCH RISKS, both known and unknown, EVEN IF ARISING FROM THE

NEGLIGENCE OF THE RELEASED PARTIES (as described below), and assumes full and sole responsibility for the Players' participation in and travel to such activities. The Player, on the Player's behalf and on behalf of the Player's personal representatives, heirs, family members, successors and assigns, hereby: (a) WAIVES, RELEASES, AND DISCHARGES the Release Parties from any and all claims or liabilities for death, personal injury, or damages of any kind which arise out of or relate to the Player's traveling to and from or participation in any volleyball or other event involving Insanity Volleyball Club, (b) AGREE NOT TO SUE any of the Release Parties for any claims or liabilities arising out of or related to the Player's travel to or participation in volleyball or other activities involving Insanity Volleyball Club, and ©INDEMNIFIES AND HOLDS HARMLESS the Released Parties from any claims made or liabilities incurred as a result of the Player's or the Player's family member's actions. The "Released Parties" include Insanity Volleyball Club, LLC, its Regional Volleyball Associations, all tournament directors, all sponsors, and the owners, managers, officers, directors, employees, subcontractors, representatives and agents, and their personal representatives, successors and/or assigns. The player further authorizes the Released Parties to obtain medical treatment in the event the Release Parties or a medical professional deems such treatment to be necessary and acknowledges that the decision to obtain such medical treatment, the treatment and the cost of such treatment are covered by all terms of the foregoing waiver and release. If Player is under 18 years of age, the Player's parent or guardian ("Representative") has executed this Waiver/Liability Release for and on behalf of the minor. In that event, the Representatives hereby bind the Representatives, the minor Player and all personas claiming by, through or under the Representatives or the Player to the terms of this Waiver/Liability Release, represents that the Representative has legal capacity and authority to act for and on behalf of the Player and agrees to indemnify and hold harmless the Release Parties from claims or liabilities assessed against them as a result of any insufficiency or the Representative's legal capacity or authority to act for and on behalf of the Player in the execution of this Waiver/Liability Release.
